What is the workshop about?

When I left the military, I lost that support system and my life seemed to do a tale spin out of control. I felt alone in my life and its struggles. All my relationships started to disintegrate. No one had my back anymore and I felt lost, confused and had no hope. I felt like a worthless shell of a man with nothing of value in my life. I was filled with so much toxic emotion that everything inside of me was shutting down.

On my journey over the last year I have found a group of men that have accepted me for who I am and they have become my brothers. They have walked with me through the dark times of my journey and have taught me how to gain healing. Now they have my back!
